

## Geometry (Shape)

horizontal = vertical =

parallel lines stay the same distance apart and never meet

right angles =



Perpendicular lines cross at a right angle

There are 1,000ml in 1L

The distance around a shape is the perimeter.

2 right angles = half turn

3 right angles = three quarter turn

4 right angles = complete turn
